Economics is a Major subject in the faculty of Arts and a compulsory subject in the faculty of Commerce in the college. The department of Economics started in the college from the academic year 1984-85 and Dr. Agnello Menezes, Head of the department, led it enthusiastically developing learners' interest and getting them engaged in curriculum. After Dr. Menezes resigned to join St. Xavier's College, Mumbai, Prof. Krishnan Nandela became the senior most faculty in the department and led very successfully. The department comprised of three full time faculty including Prof. Nagesh Suryawanshi and Prof. Dnyaneshwar Jambhule. Officially Dr. Nandela became the head of the department in 2009 and was appointed as I/c principal of the college in 2022. He retired from this position on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023. Presently Prof. Dr. Nagesh Suryawanshi is the head of the department, who is also the I/c principal of the college from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023. Miss. Neha Sharma is working as a CHB faculty in the department.

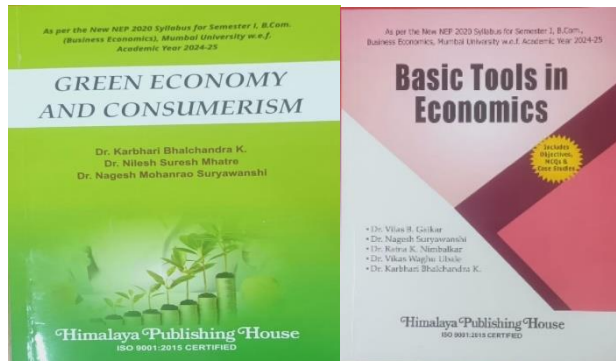

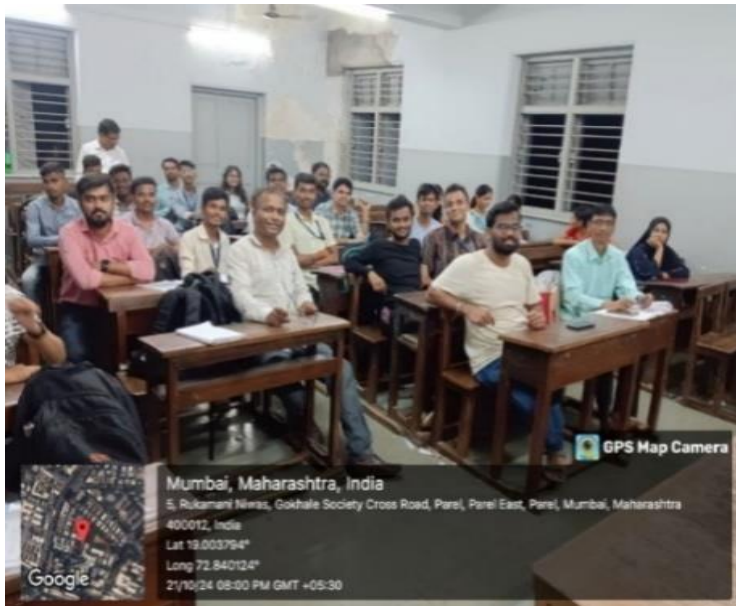

3. A group discussion on various topics in Microeconomics was organized in the classroom for FYBA Economics students. A total of 40 students participated in the discussion.





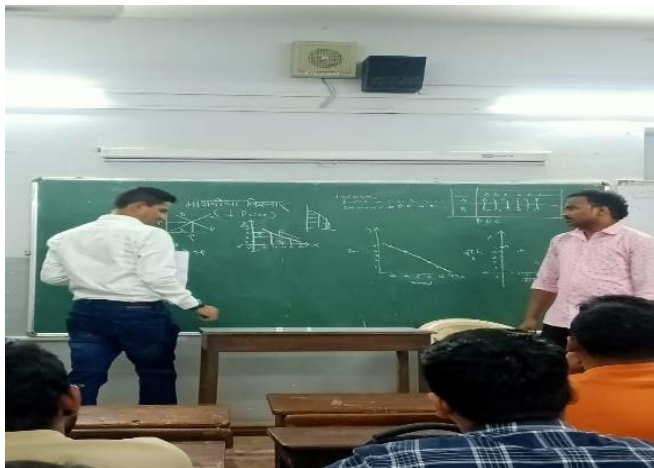

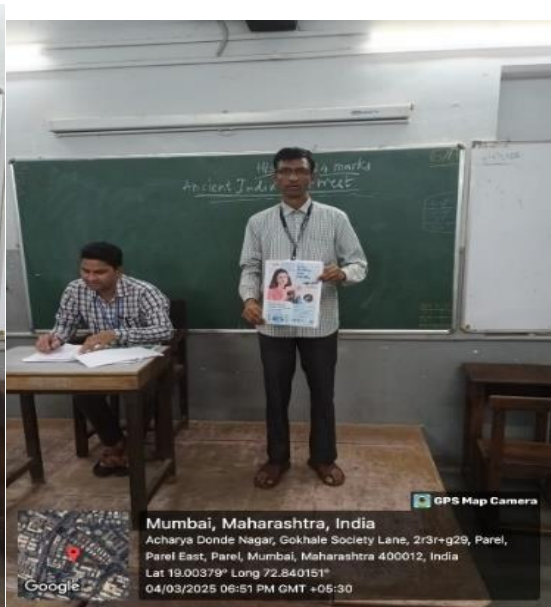
